Special Congregation Meeting on April 6th

On Sunday, April 6th, we will be holding a special meeting of the congregation at 10:15 a.m. to vote on two proposals from council. When we meet, all voting members are encouraged to attend. Even if you are not eligible to vote, but are involved in the ministry of St. Peter you are more than welcome to attend.

The two agenda items for the special Congregation Meeting are:

- 1. The Church Council presents a recommendation that the church purchase the TRICOR building (133 S Michigan Street, PDC) as a St. Peter investment that will fulfill a ministry goal established in 2022, provide space for future church needs, and generate income that can support other St. Peter Ministries.
- 2. The Church Council presents a Gift Policy and an updated Endowment Policy for approval by the congregation.

A copy of the letter to the congregation sent out from Council President Mike McCoy, a TRICOR building handout, and the full Gift and Endowment policies are available at church.

You are invited to attend an "open house" of the TRICOR building on Saturday, March 29th from 6:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., Sunday, March 30th, from 10:00 a.m. to 10:45 a.m.; or on Wednesday, April 2nd from 5:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. During these times, there will also be church council members available to answer questions at the TRICOR building (133 S Michigan St.).


